Entering 1st or 2nd Grade Suggested Reading

Summer reading is **required** for students entering grades 1 and grade 2 with prize incentives for students at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year. Students entering grade 1 are required to accumulate a minimum of **900 minutes**. Students entering grade 2 are required to accumulate a minimum of 1,000 minutes. Minutes read over the summer beginning June 3 and ending August 28, 2023, can be counted. Students will earn *a grade* for the completion of the required summer reading.
