Schoology Parent Guide

Schoology is Maranatha's Learning Management System. Schoology provides teachers a space to post assignments, resources, and grades for students to access and view. You can view your child's course materials, missing assignments, late work, and updated grades as a parent. We strive to use Schoology in our classrooms to enhance connectivity and communication across MCA.

This guide will walk you through how Schoology is used by staff and the process for accessing your Schoology Parent account.

Please review the following on how Schoology will be used at each grade level:

- Teachers will post classroom expectations and updates for Pre-k through 5th grade in the student's Homeroom course.
- Students in 4th and 5th grade may have additional assignments and class resources posted within their Schoology courses.
- Teachers will post course expectations and resources for 6th through 12th-grade in individual courses.
- 6th through 12th-grade instructors will post homework and upcoming class activities to Schoology weekly.
- All grades for students in Kindergarten- 12 will be posted in Schoology weekly. Please note that not every subject/class will post new grades every day. Keep in mind that grades near the beginning of each quarter will not reflect overall student performance. With fewer assignments being averaged together, grades are significantly affected by individual assignments.

It is very important that you activate and visit your Schoology account regularly for your child/children. Timely awareness of your child/children's performance is critical in our partnership towards the education of your child/children.





Home Page


When you log on to Schoology as a parent, you will see the parent account home page. There isn't much information listed here. Instead, you will find the most beneficial information linked to your Child Activity View account.

- 1. Click the arrow on the top right-hand side of the webpage
- 2. Below your name, you will find the name of the children linked with your account.
- 3. To view the classroom activity of your child, click on their name
 - a. Clicking on the student's name will display their account summary page
 - b. If you have multiple children, you can view individual account summaries by clicking on the arrow again to switch accounts.






Student Activity View




This Summary will show any recent grades, course updates, assignment submissions, discussion comments, and recent grades.



Student Activity will show the most recent updates, assignment submissions, comments, and assignment scores.

Enrollments will show all classes and groups your child is part of for that semester. You will also see a quick overview of grades within each course.





Courses allow you to see the Materials, Updates, and Grades of the specific courses your child is enrolled in. This view is the same as what your student sees.

Groups will show any groups your child is part of and any resources and updates from that group. This view is the same as what your student sees.

Grade Report will show detailed grades for the entire course. The Grade Report will allow you to quickly see any missing or late work. Teachers may also add grade book comments that are viewable here.

- Missing work is indicated by the orange symbol next to the assignment.
- Please note that all final grades and report cards are located within FACTS.




Notification and Account Settings

To adjust notifications for your account, click **Settings** under the drop-down menu in the upper-right hand corner. From account settings, click **Notifications**.

Follow these steps in your Child View account to control how Schoology informs you about that child's Schoology activity.

Child View Account Settings:


By default, we schedule the Parent Email Digest to be sent to your email address on file at 5:00 PM on Thursday. We highly recommended that you receive the Parent Email Digest at least once a week.





Schoology Weekly Email Report

Each Thursday evening you will receive a weekly email report with your child's course activity like what is shown below.



Course Summary:

A snapshot of your child's current course grade

Overdue Submissions:

Digital submissions that your student has not completed within Schoology. Please note that these MAY not be late or missing assignments, as your child may have already turned in a physical copy of the work.

Upcoming:

Any upcoming assignments that your student has on their account.
