



2025-2026 Dance Dress Code Guidelines

As a representative of Maranatha, we ask that all students in attendance dress respectfully. Dress code will be checked at the door as well as throughout the night. Below are the guidelines to consider while you are shopping for your dance attire.

Gentlemen

- Dress shirt with an optional tie.
- Neat jeans or casual pants.

Not allowed:

- Pants with holes or frayed hems.

Prom specific:

- Dress shirt and tie.
 - Suit coat with dress pants or a suit.
 - Tuxes are optional.
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Ladies

- Jumpsuits that follow the guidelines below are allowed.
- Dress length (and slit height) must be no higher than 4" above the knee.
- Narrow portions of midriff (2" or under) may show.

Not allowed:

- Rompers, pants, or pantsuits.
 - Dresses or slits higher than 4" above the knee.
 - Dresses may not be cut below the bust line or expose cleavage.
 - Dresses with an open back may not dip beyond the lower backline (natural waistline).
 - Exposed midriffs or bare sides.
 - If the tightness of the dress causes it to ride above the approved length, it will not be allowed.
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If these guidelines are not met

- You will be required to alter your attire to fit within these dress code standards.
- You may be asked to change entirely if the attire is not easily altered.
- Based on the attire, students may be asked to leave.
