



2026 Prom Dress Code Guidelines

As a representative of Maranatha, we ask that all students in attendance dress respectfully. Below are the guidelines to consider while you are shopping for your prom attire.

Gentlemen

- Suit coat with dress pants or a suit.
- Tuxes are optional.
- Dress shirt and tie.

Not allowed:

- Jeans or cords.

Ladies

- Formal/elegant jumpsuits that follow the guidelines below are allowed.
- Dress length must be no higher than 4" above the knee.
- SMALL cutouts on sides or back will need to be filled with mesh fabric.
- If a neckline shows cleavage, fabric will need to be added for approval.

Not allowed:

- Rompers, pants, or pantsuits.
- Dresses cut too low in the front or back.
- Spandex fabric or other tight-fitting material that clings to the body.
- Slits higher than 4" above the knee.
- Large cut outs on side or front of dress.
- Cleavage or midriffs showing.

Attire Approval

Ladies will need to receive prior approval for their attire.

- Approval request submission needs to include (front and back) photos of you in the outfit you wish to wear.
- MCA ladies – please submit your photos to your D-Group leader.
- Non-MCA – please submit your photos to sarah.rothstein@mcamustangs.org.
- The outfit you wear to prom MUST be the one you have prior approval on.
- Please do not purchase something questionable that cannot be returned.
- **Ladies' attire must be approved by administration no later than April 17, 2026.**

IF DRESS CODE IS VIOLATED ON PROM NIGHT
you will be asked to change or asked to leave.
